

Rescue Rebuild is a part of a parent organization, GreaterGood, an independent 501(c)(3) charitable organization devoted to improving the health and well-being of people, pets, and the planet. After two months in Texas helping animal shelters rebuild after Hurricane Harvey they promised to come straight to Marathon and assist in remodeling, rebuilding and re-constructing our fallen play yards.

As promised, they arrived having raised over \$20,000 to help our Marathon Campus. They brought supplies, volunteers and much needed smiles and support. For two weeks the team at Rescue Rebuild worked in the hot Florida Sun building not one, but 6 new play yards equip with Coyote Roll Bars (for fence jumpers), shade sails and enrichment toys.
